Note:

1. Till date, samples from 22847 persons have been tested for Influenza A H1N1 in various Government Laboratories across the country and 4198 (18.3 %) of them have been found positive. Of the total samples tested, 976 (4.2 %) came from Entry Screening.
2. All 97 cases reported during the day are indigenous. Of the total Lab confirmed cases 549 (13 %) are imported and the rest indigenous.
3. Five deaths are reported during the day from Maharashtra 2 (Pune 1; Thane 1) and Karnataka 1 (Mysore 1) and Andhra Pradesh 2 (Hyderabad 2).
4. On 1st September 2009, 32579 passengers have been screened at 83 counters manned by 225 doctors and 172 paramedics. Total passengers screened till date is 5431199.
